The trip began with lot of enthusiasm and vigor. The National Gallery showcase a large number of folk and tribal paintings. The gallery included information on changing lifestyles of people in India over a time. The students were shown a short documentary on Indian Culture. After this the students accompanied by faculty members went to uniquely themed park, Waste to Wonder, located at SaraiKale Khan. The park houses seven Wonders of ancient, medieval and modern world. The students were delighted to see replica of TajMahal, The Eiffel Tower, statue of Liberty of New York, The statue of the Christ the Redeemer, The Great Pyramid of Giza and The Colosseum in Rome. The South Delhi Municipal Corporation (SDMC) has harnessed wind and solar energy to light up the park rendering a breathtaking sight at sunset and after dark. Students were amazed to learn that 150 tons of waste material like scrap metal retrieved from Delhi's landfills was used to recreate the monuments.


