



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
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<u>Report on one day National Conference conducted on 5th November,</u> <u>2022</u>









Prof. (Dr.) Manoj Kumar Singh Convener (Anvesha 2022 National Conference) Giving the welcome address for the Conference.

The chief guest, Prof. Pratusha Mandal, blessed us with his multidimensional speech in which he covered all the different fields like, Skill development, Entrepreneurship value education, technological



development at global level, pedagogy, culture etc. Through his address critically analyzed the nation's perspective, economic growth is dependent on productivity of industry and its people. People can be productive, provided they enjoy good health, have access to quality education, relevant skills, and are made aware of livelihood opportunities presented by the economic growth around them. 
"If education gives us the knowledge of what we have to do, skill teaches us how it will be done in actuality," the prime minister said.








Participants presenting Research paper

II. Technical Session 2 (Conference Hall Block A- 2.30 PM to 4.30 PM)


