



Content	The MIMT organized a Workshop for their teaching and non-teaching Staff on "Transactional Analysis: A funnel to Conflict Resolution. Dr. Azad Singh was the resource person for the workshop. Dr. Azad Singh explained about Transactional Analysisthat transactional analysis usually served as a powerful framework for understanding human behavior and communication patterns. He told that transactional analysis provided insights into how individuals interact and respond in various social transactions. When applied to conflict resolution, transactional analysis provided a structured approach to dissecting conflicts, identifying their root causes, and implementing strategies for resolution. In this workshop, participants delved into the fundamentals of transactional analysis and explored about, how it can be utilized as a funnel to navigate conflicts towards constructive outcomes. A Total 18 employees from teaching and non-teaching participated overall.
Outcome of Activity	Dr.Azad Singh explained in detailed about Transactional Analysis, as transactional analysisserves as a comprehensive framework for dissecting conflicts and fostering effective communication in day-to-day life. By understanding ego states, transactional patterns, and communication dynamics Staff Members can navigate conflicts with clarity and empathy. The workshop aimed to equip participants with the knowledge and skills necessary to utilize transactional analysis as a funnel towards constructive conflict resolution, ultimately fostering healthier and more productive relationships.
